REGISTRATION CHECKLIST

All teams registering for the Flag City Fall Classic (FCFC) Soccer Tournament must present the proper materials, fully completed, in order to participate. We do not register players or teams at the fields. All team registrations are handled online.

This form is designed to help make certain that you have all information necessary to register your team. Missing or incomplete information may cause your team to be rejected from competition. Please see that you have everything on this list fully completed. If you have any questions about this information, contact tournament@pacesettersouth.com.

REMINDERS:

- US Club teams do not need a travel permit.
- All other teams with travel permits must scan and email it to tournament@pacesettersouth.com upon acceptance to the tournament or upon receipt of travel permit.
- Medical Release forms do not need notarization.

The following is a checklist of items that your team should complete prior to registration. Registration questions and registration documents can be emailed to tournament@pacesettersouth.com.

____ **2 Copies of Approved Team Roster for Fall 2017**

Roster must contain no more than maximum number of players that are listed in our rules, inclusive of any guest players: 12 players-U9 and U10; 14 players-U11 and U12; 18 players-U13 and U14/15.

____ **Guest Player Roster Form**

Teams may have no more than 4 guest players. FCFC Guest player form is available on the tournament web site. USYSA teams must use only use USYSA guest players. US Club registered teams must use only US Club registered guest players. No exceptions.

____ **Player Cards**

Each player on the main roster and on the guest player roster must have a Fall 2017 valid player card.

____ **Liability Release Form**

All parents must have signed this form!

____ **Weekend Contact Information Form**

Required for each team.

____ **Permit to Travel (For teams outside of Ohio-North)**

Teams outside of Ohio-North must contact their state office to obtain a permission to travel form prior to making the trip. This form should already have been submitted to the tournament. Please bring an extra copy to the tournament. US Club Soccer teams are not required to obtain a permission to travel.
